Our Guest Speaker Today

Dr. Russell Burrill became an Adventist in his late teens through the ministry of the Voice of Prophecy. He graduated from Atlantic Union College, the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary at Andrews University, and Fuller Theological Seminary. His ministry has included seven years pastoring in Connecticut and Maryland, followed by seven years full-time evangelism in Mountain View, Chesapeake, and Upper Columbia Conferences, followed by another seven years pastoring in Spokane, Washington and Wichita, Kansas. Dr. Burrill has also served as Director of the North American Division Evangelism Institute, Seminary Professor and Secretary of the North American Division Ministerial Association until his retirement in 2007. Along the way Dr. Russell Burrill has authored numerous articles, Bible study lessons, and books including: Revolution in the Church, Radical Disciples for Revolutionary Churches, Rekindling a Lost Passion, Hope When Your World Falls Apart, and Waking the Dead. Dr. Burrill and his wife Cynthia currently live outside of Berrien Springs, Michigan.
