

Rockwood Adventist Town Hall Meeting December 1, 2012

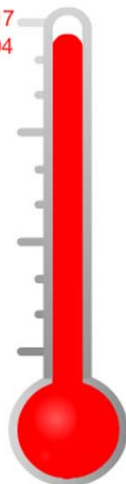
