In the book of Acts we discover that God poured out His Spirit in Pentecost power after His church spent ten days together, pleading for His promised blessing. He is ready to do it again today! All around the world Adventist churches are experiencing the renewal of the Holy Spirit by following the disciples' example and participating in the annual Ten Days of Prayer. It's time to unleash His power here in Rockwood.

Each day a different aspect of 2 Peter 2:1-11 will be explored along with specific intercessory prayer needs. On day one we'll be praying for revival and reformation in our community. On day two we will pray for God's Word to become foundational in people's lives. Day three's intercessory focus will be the faith of our children and families and their Christian education. We'll pray for God to break down the enemy's strongholds in our city on day four and for the people of our city to recognize their need for God in their lives.

The prayers on day five will be for the mission of Rockwood Adventist to become a reality in the life of every member. Day six our prayers will be for the health ministries of our worldwide church. Then on day seven our prayers will be for the worldwide mission of the Adventist Church. On the eighth day we'll pray for our church leaders. Reconciliation and unity in our families and church will be our focus on day nine. And then on day ten will cap off the week with prayers for a renewal of God's love in our community.
