

News from the Pastor's Desk

Thank You! Your continued support of Rockwood Adventist through gifts of time and financial resources continue to make an eternal difference. Through May the cost of our daily operation here at Rockwood averaged \$405 per day. If every person who has attended Rockwood this year gave an equal amount of offerings to support the church they would need to have given an average of \$70.64 per week. For some people \$70 a week is a drop in the bucket while for others it represents an unreasonably high proportion of their weekly income.

So what's the solution for funding the mission of our church? It is not equal giving - it is equal sacrifice! When each one of us sets aside an equal percentage of our weekly income we share proportionately and together we bare the weight of the cross as we carry it throughout our neighborhood offering eternal life to all who will respond. Thank you for prayerfully considering investing 4% of your income on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis to help Jesus accomplish His mission through Rockwood Adventist.
