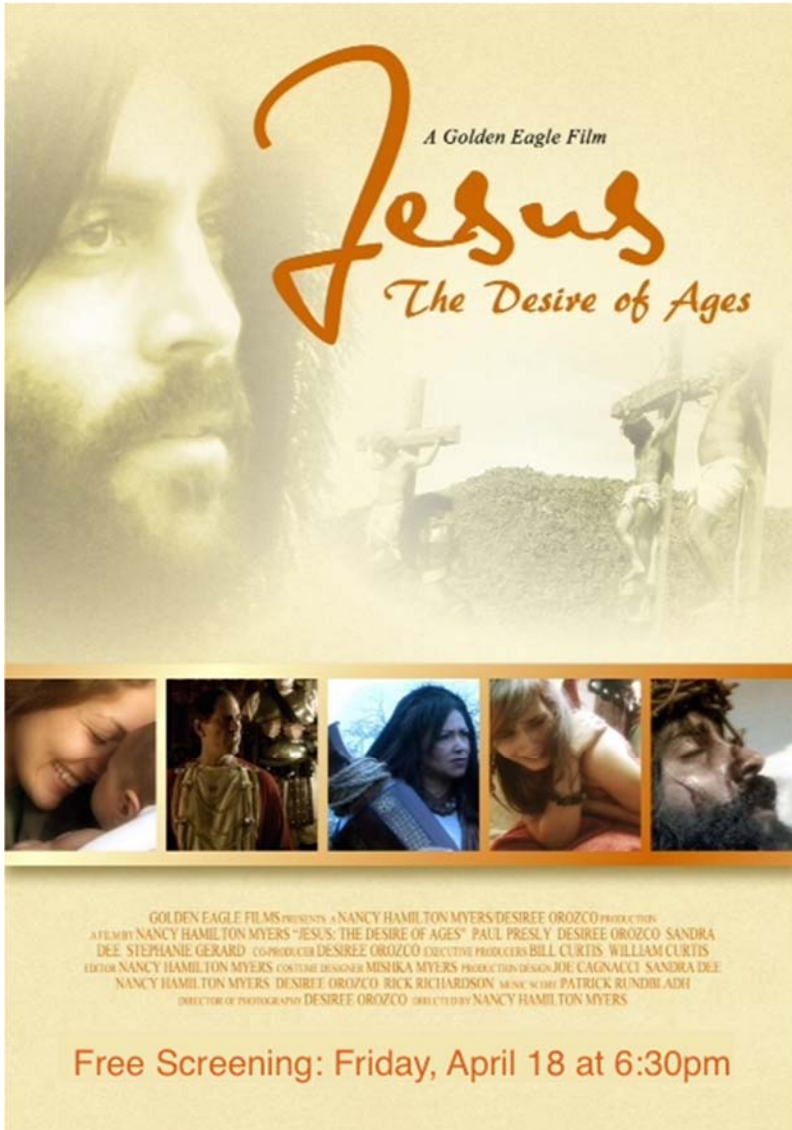


Friendship Sabbath
