



The Pathfinder's Journey to the International Camporee

In less than 90 days our Rockwood Pathfinders will be on the road to the international camporee in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. This year they will be joined by over 35,000 other Pathfinders from around the world for six days dedicated to claiming, reclaiming & retaining youth for Christ and His Church. Fourteen youth, four sponsors, five support staff and our pastor will represent Rockwood before the worldwide Adventist church. Plus, our team will be hosting a fifteen member international Pathfinder club from Africa.

As you probably know by now our Pathfinders have been working hard for several years to raise the over \$30,000 necessary to participate in this once in a lifetime - life changing event. Between now and July 20 there are several ways you can show our young people your support.

First, we are looking for financial sponsors for four Karen Pathfinders. The trip to Oshkosh is sixteen days in total and the average daily cost is \$65 per day per Pathfinder. If you could sponsor one or more days please contact Scott Hill or Pastor Gene. Second, we are looking for sponsors to help raise the \$1,500 needed for the African Pathfinder club that we will be hosting in Oshkosh. For \$100 you can sponsor food and camping expenses for one of our fifteen international guests. Third, we need \$2,800 to purchase a large industrial style tent for use as a dining tent during Oshkosh and for future Pathfinder outings. Finally, during the Oregon Conference campmeeting Rockwood Pathfinders will be selling burgers and fries at the Snack Shack. Nina Kight is coordinating adult volunteers to staff three shifts July 15-19, which will generate nearly \$7,000 for Oshkosh.

Your tax deductible offerings earmarked "Oshkosh" combined with the estimated \$9,000 the Pathfinders will raise during their remaining fundraisers will ensure that our young people meet their goal and have a life changing experience at the International Camporee.
