

## Seeing Jesus through Muslims Eyes

**Mark your calendars** and plan to be at Rockwood on November 15 for a special worship service, concert and seminar entitled "Seeing Jesus through Muslim eyes".

Pastor Gerald Babanezhad, the coordinator of Muslim Ministries for the Pacific Union and a member of the board of advisors to the North American Division's Adventist-Muslim Relations Group, will be our guest speaker. As the director of A Sure Harvest Ministries and pastor of a Middle Eastern congregation in Southern California Pastor Babanezhad's ministry focuses on helping people understand Islam, the Koran, and how to more effectively reach Muslims with the love of Jesus. Through his television programs, which are seen by millions of Muslims around the globe, underground churches have formed in Central Asia and hundreds of Muslims have accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

During the worship service, Pastor Babanezhad will be presenting some of the profound precedents and models set forth in the New Testament by our Lord Jesus and subsequently by apostles Peter and Paul in reaching the most difficult population groups with the Gospel.

Pastor Babanezhad also frequents places like Carnegie Hall as piano composer and performing artist. Following our fellowship meal he will present a number of piano selections leading into his afternoon presentation.

The afternoon presentation/seminar will be eye opening, focusing on 1) Biblical setting of Abraham's descendancy through Ishmael, 2) The teachings of the Quran in regards to the Old Testament (Tawrah) and Hebrew prophets and the Gospels (Injeel), 3) What the Quran says about Jesus Christ (Isa al-Masih) and the incredible honor that it bestows upon the Savior. This information will take down the barrier and equip us to relate and reach out to Muslims. Don't miss this opportunity to become better prepared to share Jesus.
