When gunmen stormed Garissa University College, located in Garissa, Kenya, on April 2, they left nearly 150 people dead. Now local Adventist leaders report that 10 of the murdered students were Adventist members. Reports of the tragedy indicate that members of a terrorist group specifically targeted and killed Christian students.
