Making a House a Home – Doh Soe, our new Bible Worker and leader of our Karen Refugee ministry, has returned to North Carolina to help his family make the transition to Portland. They will be joining him here in ministry on June 16. As a part of that transition they made the decision to donate all of their earthly belongings, except their clothing, to a new family of refugees who is making their home in North Carolina.

To welcome Doh Soe and his family and thank them for the sacrifice they are making to help Rockwood's Karen ministry we would like to surprise them with everything they need to make their house in Portland feel like home.

Several furniture and other small items have already been donated and a complete list of items will be posted on the bulletin board this Sabbath. You can help by donating one of the items on the list or making a cash donation for one of the items that we would like them to personally go shopping for once they arrive. There are five in Doh Soe's family. Their children range in age from infant to seven.

Kitchen Items: Pot & Pan set, silverware set, plates, bowls, saucer and cup set, pitcher, cutting board, table and chairs, microwave, garbage can, \$50 for a rice cooker.

Bedroom Items: New Pillows, blankets, sheet sets (Twin and Queen), dressers, mirrors.

Bathroom Items: Washcloths, towels, floor mat, tissue.

Children's Items: Cash for bike tires and helmets for donated bikes, other toys for three boys (infant, toddler and 2nd grader).
