Alcyon Fleck, Co-Founder of International Children's Care, Dead at age 93 - Fleck died on May 25 in Walla Walla, Washington, and was buried next to her husband, Kenneth, at a family graveside service. A memorial service will be held on Sept. 5 at the Meadow Glade Adventist Church near Vancouver, Washington, where International Children's Care is based. Robert Robinson, 'Walking Miracle' Who Opened 1,500 Churches in India, Dead at 72 - Robinson, a missionary and church administrator who opened more than 1,500 Seventh-day Adventist churches and two schools in India despite serious health challenges, has died after a sudden heart attack. He was laid to rest at the Fair Oaks Cemetery near Sutherlin, Oregon, on May 10. Memorial services have been held over the past month in the United States and in India.
