School Supply Drive - We are teaming up with several other Christian Churches in the Rockwood neighborhood to raise funds for low income families in Rockwood needing school supplies. The goal of the program is to raise enough funds to purchase 100 backpacks with basic school supplies so we can distribute them on August 4 at the Rockwood Neighborhood night out.
