Rockwood Community News

Rockwood Will Be Open on Campmeeting Sabbath, July 25, and a live feed from Gladstone will be shown. There will be one adult Sabbath-school class at 9:30 am and the broadcast from the campground will start about 10:45 am.

The Church Office Will Be Closed July 19 through August 2. Voice mail messages will be picked up periodically during this time.

Rockwood Church Campout and Outdoor Church July 31-August 2

We will be in Group Campsite 1 this year. Check-in/check-out time is noon on both Friday and Sunday. Campers & trailers must stay on gravel. Tents can be in the woods or the field. The Oxbow gates close each night at legal sunset and open at 6:30 in the morning. Please, if you want to camp and haven’t signed up yet, do so today. The sign-up sheet is on the bulletin board by the main entrance. Camping cost is \$10 per person or \$30 per family for the whole weekend, plus the \$5 gate entrance fee per vehicle. If you have not paid your camping fee yet, please do so as soon as possible. Checks need to be made payable to the Church, with a note for Oxbow camping or gate pass. Those who are camping do NOT need to get a pre-paid gate pass. These are only for the people who are coming in on Sabbath for Outdoor Church.

Outdoor Church on August 1 will start at 10:00 am. The church will provide shamburgers and hotdogs with all the fixings. We’re asking you to provide salads, snacks and desserts. Please bring your lawn chairs. Parking and “facilities” are close by. Gate passes will be available in the lobby after the service this morning. So far no one has signed up for bus service from Rockwood to the Campground on August 1. If you are interested in this please sign-up today!

Rockwood Will Also be Open on August 1, for those who can’t get out to Oxbow Park. It will start at 9:30 am with one adult Sabbath-school class, but no children’s classes.

There Will Be NO Board Meeting in July - Board members, please watch for an email regarding our student aid requests.

Don’t Have Transportation to Church? If you or someone you know would like to attend church but can’t because of a lack of transportation, please contact the church office and register for van service.
