An Urgent Call for Missionaries - The North American Division of Seventh-day Adventists' Office of Volunteer Ministries is seeking volunteers between the ages of 18 to 70 who are baptized members of the Adventist church and committed followers of Jesus, who can fund their own airline ticket to a missionary adventure.

Guam-Micronesia Mission has 54 positions to fill in their eight island schools as they begin their school year! The islands of Ebeye, Yap, Chuuk, and Kosrae currently have the greatest needs, and may be unable to begin their school year unless teachers arrive soon. The mission school will provide volunteers with accommodations, a modest living allowance, and accident/illness travel insurance.
