Prayer for the Tucker Family - Gayle Tucker, one of the Seventh-day Adventist Church's best-known female television personalities, and a pastor, author, and counselor credited with lighting a fire under thousands of marriages, died less than a month after learning that she had pancreatic cancer. She was 60.

Tucker, associate speaker of the *Faith for Today* television ministry and co-host of its popular flagship "Lifestyle Magazine" program, died on Sunday, April 10, at her home in Dallas, Texas.
