**Sponsor a Brazilian Pathfinder** – In 2014 our Pathfinder club hosted the leaders of two Brazilian Pathfinder Clubs in Oshkosh. Fabio Silva leads "Clube Israel" in Uberlândia, Minas Gerais, Brazil. This club plays a major role in ministering to the needs of the children in a very poor neighborhood. Thirty-one of these kids are members of "Clube Israel." In July their local conference will hold a Pathfinder Camporee and Fabio would like to take all thirty-one of his pathfinders to the camporee. However, due their economic situation that is impossible without outside support. The cost for each pathfinder is U\$120 (R\$430) including bus fair, meals, and camporee tickets.
