

Global Refugee Facts

The ongoing refugee crisis in Europe may have grabbed the media's attention, but it is only one example of refugee movements in the world. Beyond sensational headlines, there is so much more to know about these displaced men, women, and children who are often escaping the same terror that many of us fear.

- Almost 60 million people in the world are displaced. Around 20 million are refugees who have had to flee to another country, and close to 40 million are internally displaced persons (IDPs) who are still within their own countries.
- More than 40,000 people are forced from their homes every day due to violence or fear.
- Half of the world's refugees are children.
- More than 50% of refugees are from 3 countries – Syria, Afghanistan, and Somalia.
- Syria now accounts for the largest refugee population, with more than 3 million forced to flee the country. Another 7.6 million are IDPs within Syria.
- More than 1 million refugees crossed into Europe in 2015 – most from Syria, but thousands also from Afghanistan, Iraq, and other conflict-affected countries.
- More than 5,000 men, women, and even unaccompanied children lost their lives during their search for safety and a better life in 2015.
- Already this year, 179,552 refugees and migrants have reached Europe by sea, with nearly 800 losing their lives during the journey.
- In March 2016, borders throughout Europe closed to refugees leaving nearly 50,000 people stranded in Greece with no way forward.
