The Cootz Girls are collecting flannel to take back to Tanzania when they return to Africa at the end of September. It can be new or used flannel, of any color or pattern. Old sheet sets are great!

Our Agriculture school is high-school-age students who for many reasons have not been able to attend regular school. They are at risk teens who have not been given the basic opportunities to have an education.

The girls who attend our agriculture school learn much more than agriculture. One of the classes that they take at our Kibidula mission is sewing. The first thing they learn in the class is to sew their clothes by hand. After they have learned this, they are taught to sew using the treadle sewing machine. They are taught to sew amazing garments without a pattern. These skills will be very helpful in their future as they provide for their families. Many of them may also choose to have a sewing business.

Flannel is the fabric of choice, and the only fabric we are collecting at this time. If anyone has some flannel sheets they are not using, we would love to take it back so our Kibidula girls can have the opportunity to make much needed items.

PACS and other Second-hand stores usually carry flannel sheets. Or, if you would like to donate money and have us purchase these, we can do that also.

We need to have this flannel, or donations, to Rockwood by Sabbath, September 9. There will be a tub marked "Flannel" in the coat-rack area. Mark your checks or tithe envelopes for "Flannel."
