Karen/India Building Project

The Karen people have a large community on the northern islands of India, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. They are not allowed by the Indian government to build a "Church," but they will be allowed to build a "Community Center." They have several plots of land that are available on the main road, and they could purchase the land and build the center for about \$30,000. The Karen people throughout the US, including those in our Rockwood group, are trying to raise these funds as quickly as possible, while the window of opportunity is open.
