

## PACS Volunteer Opportunities

There are three areas that need additional volunteers: cashiering, truck driver or rider, and receptionist in the Food Pantry. Cashiers run the cash register and process credit cards and occasionally help clean and organize the store. Truck driver or rider assists in loading foods at various grocery stores and food banks, then return to PACS to unload (no special driver's license required to drive but you must have experience driving trucks). ## Pathfinder Injured in Florida Shooting

On Valentine's Day 17 were killed and 14 were injured when a gunman opened fire at a high school in Parkland, Fla. Adventist Community Services offered support to American Red Cross leadership on what help the school might need from the disaster response community. Samantha Grady, a Pathfinder who is a student at Parkland, is one of the injured in this latest shooting.

Grady said she took her best friend's advice to use a book to shield herself from the bullets that flew into the classroom, where she and others were huddled behind furniture.

A NBC story reports that Grady was working on an assignment about the Holocaust when she heard two shots in the hallway. Her best friend pushed her down, and the two then ran toward a big bookshelf. The friend urged Grady to grab a book and use it for protection. Grady's friend, who was attending church with Grady, according to family friends, did not survive.
