Roland R. Hegstad, an Adventist minister, author, and editor, passed to his rest on June 17, 2018. He was 92. Hegstad, a 1949 graduate of Walla Walla University, became an expert in international religious liberty. His work took him around the globe, to the Soviet Union and Eastern Europe. Hegstad edited *Liberty* magazine for 35 years until his retirement in 1994. Throughout the years, *Liberty* won multiple awards for excellence in art and design from the Associated Church Press. A memorial service to celebrate the life of Roland R. Hegstad has been scheduled for Sabbath, August 4, at 3:30 pm, at the Spencerville Adventist Church, 16325 New Hampshire Avenue, Silver Spring, MD.
