Inventor of the “Haystack” Passes

Ella May Hartlein, who for years worked alongside her husband in Adventist academies across the United States, passed away on Sabbath morning, June 30, 2018, at the age of 98. Mrs. Hartlein is credited with the invention of the haystack, a dish popular in Seventh-day Adventist church communal and home gatherings across North America and around the world. It was originally known as “The Hartlein Special.” No one knows for sure when or where it became known as the “Haystack!”
