

## Free Food Market & PACS COW

Oregon Food Bank news release, April 2018:

“In an average month, an estimated 260,000 people are receiving food from a food pantry in the Oregon Food Bank Network. The rate of food insecurity (being without access to a sufficient quantity of affordable, nutritious food) in Oregon is 14.6%. About 552,900 Oregonians are food insecure, of those 194,070 are children.”

On an average Sabbath, attendance at Rockwood Adventist is 175 people. Look around. If 14.6% of the congregation were food insecure, that means 26 people sitting near you might not have access to sufficient affordable, nutritious food. Maybe you are that person.

Rockwood Adventist volunteers have been making an impact on food insecurity every month at PACS COW and the Free Food Market. PACS COW (Commodities on Wheels) visits the Rockwood Building, at 124 NE 181st, every 2nd Monday from 4-6 pm. This mobile food pantry provides food to at least 28-30 needy qualified families each month.

Another opportunity is Harvest Share, renamed Free Food Market in May, 2018. Oregon Food Bank has relocated Free Food Market from the Rockwood Adventist parking lot to the Rockwood building to allow better access by public transportation. The MAX Blue Line is only 1 block away. Every 4th Tuesday from 8-10 AM, the Free Food Market welcomes anyone who needs fresh fruit and vegetables.

If you are food insecure, please come to these events. Rockwood Adventist volunteers are always needed and welcome at the COW and Free Food Market.

As a volunteer, you can make a difference for our Rockwood friends and neighbors at the COW on Aug. 13 and the Free Food Market on Aug. 28.
