"It has been my honor to serve as the Treasurer," Gosney wrote in announcing the change. "I'm thankful for the trust that you've put in me along the way. The decision to move on was difficult. Yet as surely as I know that God called me to the Oregon Conference, I feel His call today toward this next chapter of ministry. I am confident that the right administrative and treasury team is in place to carry the Conference through this transition and into the next level of mission growth."

The search for a new Treasurer commences immediately. In the interim, the current treasury team, led by Undertreasurer Brent Plubell, will be able to effectively serve the needs of the Oregon Conference and its constituents. Brian and his wife Sharon will stay in the Portland area as Brian takes on his new responsibilities at GCAS.
